Our Learning

Math: We are continuing to round numbers to all place values next week. This can be difficult as it requires a lot of number sense to round. We will end the week by practicing how to construct an argument/explain our thinking when we write about math. This is a helpful skill in 4<sup>th</sup> grade since the students are required to answer questions in writing on the KPREP test at the end of the year.

**Reading:** This week we are continuing to study text structures by looking for key words and clues in a text. We will finish up this short unit and take a test by Friday.

Grammar: We are continuing to study sentences. We will continu to work on identifying the subject and predicate of a sentence. will also be sorting sentences into 4 different types: Declarative, Imperative, Exclamatory, and Interrogative. These are just fancy names for statements, commands, exclamations, and questions.

Science: Our first exploration of volcanoes took a little longer last week than expected. We are picking up with "Why do some volcanoes explode?" this week. We will be studying different types of lava and rocks that come from volcanoes of different shapes.
